If you cannot answer YES to each of these questions, you need to work harder outside of the rehearsal time in preparation. The old adage is "the band is only as good as its weakest member." This is so true. Strive to be the best member of the band this week. Remember how contagious an **attitude** is, both positive and negative. Either will go a long way. Think about how much success we can accomplish with a positive attitude from EVERYONE.

A few competition reminders---

- ---<u>Always</u> wear undergarments that others are comfortable seeing you in. Undershirts (men), camisoles (women).
